

# Well-Child Benefits for Medicaid and FAMIS enrolled children



Children can get free well-child check-ups through Medicaid and FAMIS. Regular check-ups let the doctor make sure that the child is growing up healthy and getting the immunizations that all children need. At a check-up, the doctor will look for any health problems. If health problems are found early, they may be treated before they get worse.

Ask your child's doctor about scheduling a well-child check-up.

- Mental health screens
- Substance Abuse screens
- Immunizations
- Health education for parents
- Referral for diagnosis and/or treatment
